# Our Vision

Beat Childhood Cancer drives childhood cancer research and raises awareness, making a difference in kids' survival today. Our vision is to change the story for the next family by finding viable treatments and, ultimately, cures for childhood cancers.

## GLOBAL OUTREACH AND EXPANSION

The Beat Childhood Cancer Research Consortium has finalized an agreement with Resonance Health to serve as the International Contract Research Organization to oversee clinical trials outside of North America. The first international partner to join will be Hospital Sant Joan de Déu in Barcelona, Spain, under the leadership of Dr. Jaume Mora.

IWILFIN (DFMO) is now available for high-risk neuroblastoma patients in the U.S. and Israel. Regulatory reviews are underway in the UK, Switzerland, Australia, and the EU. A partnership has been finalized for China and Taiwan and multiple programs are in place to support global access to IWILFIN in countries where the product is not yet approved.

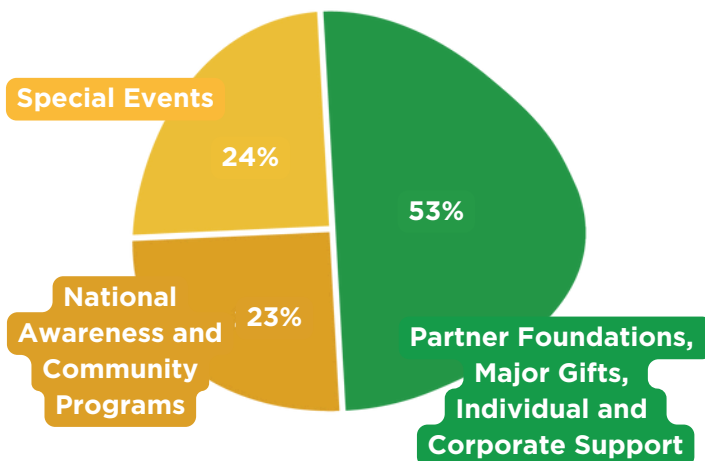
### Where the Money Goes

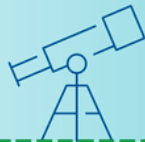
## Traditional Healthcare System Cancer-Centric Approach

**PATIENT-CENTRIC CARE** We ask the fundamental question: "What can we do to save this child in front of me?"



**TAILORED TREATMENTS**  
Customized for each child's unique body and tumor.

**EXPLORE LESS TOXIC OPTIONS**  
Using collaborative research, we find effective treatments that already exist.



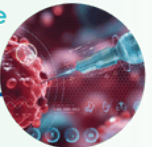
**CLOSE TO HOME**  
The best treatment should not require moving across the country.



If further treatment is necessary, parents are guided to other resources and options available, regardless of proximity.

**SCIENTIFIC INQUIRY** Rigorous scientific inquiry that dictates care and overlooks the needs of the individual child.



**LIMITED OPTIONS**  
Treatments are often determined by what narrow approaches are funded, not by the needs of the child and their specific tumor.

**ATTACK CANCER VS. TREATING THE CHILD**  
Focus is on attacking the cancer at all costs, often at the expense of the child.

The treatment becomes **AS DEADLY** as the cancer.



When limited, narrow treatments fail, parents are often told there is **NO** hope — and to go home and keep their child comfortable.
